Joseph Ferretti holds a Bachelor of Music in Piano Performance from the University of Colorado-Boulder, where he was the recipient of numerous awards and scholarships. Dr. Ferretti has performed throughout Europe, Canada and the United States as both soloist and collaborative artist. Some recent performances include the Four Seasons Centre's Piano Virtuoso Series, the Canadian Music Centre's New Music in New Places, with such ensembles as the Kitchener Waterloo Symphony, and on numerous university concert series throughout North America. Dr. Ferretti frequently performs as a duo pianist with Elaine Lau, with whom he has recorded for Capstone Records. He can also be heard on numerous recordings at the Canadian Music Centre. Dr. Ferretti has presented workshops and lecture recitals for such schools as the Glenn Gould School of The Royal Conservatory, Mt. Allison University, and McMaster University. As a member of the *junctQín keyboard collective*, he has participated in numerous concerts, festivals, installations, and workshops that involve the performance and generation of innovative works for keyboard. Dr. Ferretti has taught piano at Wilfrid Laurier University since 2003. For several years he held a summer residency in the Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Arts, working with talented youth. In addition, he maintains a private studio in Toronto throughout the year.
